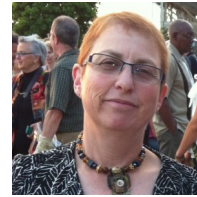
BOARD OF ASSESSMENT APPEALS

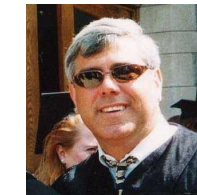
